Why Dental Veneers are Worth Considering?

Dental veneers are thin, custom-made shells made of tooth-coloured materials, such as porcelain or composite resin. They are made to cover the front surface of your teeth, enhancing their appearance and improving your smile.

Veneers can be used to address various cosmetic dental concerns, including stained, chipped, misaligned, or worn-down teeth.

The process of getting dental veneers typically involves the following steps:

1. Consultation: During your initial consultation with Smile Collective, our dentist will assess your oral health and discuss your smile pursuits. We will determine if you are a suitable candidate for veneers and explain the procedure in detail.
2. Treatment Planning: Our dentist will take impressions of your teeth, which will be used to prepare custom veneers that fit your smile. The colour, size, and shape of the veneers will be discussed to assure they fulfil your desired aesthetic outcome.
3. Preparation: A small portion of enamel will be removed from the front surface of your teeth to make space for the veneers. This step is usually painless and performed under local anesthesia.
4. Temporary Veneers (if necessary): In some cases, temporary veneers may be placed while your custom veneers are being fabricated in a dental laboratory. These temporary veneers will save your teeth and give you a conception of what your final result will look like.
5. Veneer Bonding: Once your custom veneers are prepared, we will carefully bond them to the front surface of your teeth using a dental adhesive. The veneers will be adjusted for fit and comfort, and any necessary final refinements will be made.

Caring for your New Veneers?

To ensure your smile investment lasts as long as possible, we recommend caring for veneers as if they were natural teeth. Make a habit to brush them with a soft toothbrush twice a day, floss daily, use sensitive toothpaste, and plan regular checkups. Wearing a protective nightguard to sleep in is also beneficial. It is a good idea to avoid hard, crispy and tough-to-chew foods such as nuts, coffee, tea, wine, chips and steak. However, you should be aware that dental veneers will have to be replaced after some time, regardless of how well you take care of them.
